## PRACTICAL

<b>Visa Requirement</b>	Once the application has been approved, you will need to obtain a Non –Immigrant ED Visa to enter to Thailand. This visa can be extended once your studies have commenced. Do not enter Thailand on a tourist or transit visa as these are not issued for study purposes and cannot be extended to cover the entire duration of your period of study.
<b>Arrival</b>	2 weeks before semester starts
<b>Airport transfer</b>	Yes
<b>Insurance</b>	Students should have their own health insurance from their home university
<b>Accommodation</b>	Off campus, we will accompany your student to find a suitable dormitory with a good reasonable price
<b>Estimated Living Cost</b>	10,000 Baht / month ( Dormitory and living expense)
