APPLICATION

Application Deadline	At least 3 months before the start of the program.
Eligibility	Be a current student and nominated by AUN member university
Application Procedure	<p>Interested students should apply directly through the AUN-ACTS website. Following an initial screening, the host Faculty / College may ask a potential student to submit its own version of a student exchange application form along with all the following required documents:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Official transcript from home institute 2. Letter of approval from home institute to study abroad as an exchange student at MU 3. Copy of passport 4. Copy of health insurance information 5. Completed Exchange Student Application form 6. Completed Housing Application 7. Health Insurance Information <p>A statement of interest and proof of English proficiency may be requested by some host Faculties / Colleges.</p>

PRACTICAL

Visa Requirement	All students are required to obtain a student visa before entering Thailand. A letter of acceptance / supporting letter will be issued for the application of an education visa at the Royal Thai Embassy in the student's country.
Arrival	The incoming students should arrive in Thailand at least three days before the start of the semester. Orientation / information sessions will be organized prior to the start of the program.
Airport transfer	Airport pickups can occasionally be provided. If not, comprehensive directions will be available.
Insurance	Students are required to purchase their own international health insurance plans from their home countries and bring all relevant documents with them.
Accommodation	Affordable housing is widely available both on-and-off the campus. On-campus accommodation is limited and is on a first-come-first-served basis. Private accommodation is widely available and can be easily organized.
Estimated Living Cost	<p>Living costs vary according to lifestyle and preferences. However, a rough could be as follows:</p> <p>Accommodation: 5,000 – 7,500 Thai Baht (ThB) per month Food/Meals: 4,500 - 9,000 ThB per month Local Transportation: 2,000 ThB per month</p> <p><i>(1 USD is approximately 33 ThB)</i></p>
