	Thailand. A letter of acceptance / supporting letter will be issued for the
	application of an education visa at the Royal Thai Embassy in the
	student's country.
Arrival	The incoming students should arrive in Thailand at least three days before
	the start of the semester. Orientation / information sessions will be
	organized prior to the start of the program.
Airport transfer	Airport pickups can occasionally be provided. If not, comprehensive
	directions will be available.
Insurance	Students are required to purchase their own international health
	insurance plans from their home countries and bring all relevant
	documents with them.
Accommodation	Affordable housing is widely available both on-and-off the campus. On-
	campus accommodation is limited and is on a first-come-first-served
	basis. Private accommodation id widely available and can be easily
	organized.
Estimated Living Cost	Living costs vary according to lifestyle and preferences. However, a rough
	could be as follows:
