WHAT IS ACTS

ASEAN CREDIT TRANSFER SYSTEM

ASEAN Credit Transfer System (ACTS) is a student-centered system applied to student mobility among AUN member universities. The system was developed to accommodate the differences in the implementation of credit system among AUN member universities. For future development, it is also expanded other selected ASEAN+ universities.

ACTS comprises three components:

1. Online Application System: most of the selection process would be done through ACTS online application system. This allows students not only to submit their application online, but also to learn their application status.
2. Courses Database: ACTS compiles available courses offered by AUN member universities. There are more than 12,000 courses available in ACTS courses database.
3. Grading Scale: to simplify

the grade conversion task, the member universities have agreed to set one grading scale which is called ACTS grade.

ACTS mainly focuses on promoting people to people linkage with three

aims: enrichment of purposes, enhancement of students' soft skills and exposure of international experience.

ACTS also benefits students in three ways: credit earning intellectual exchange and networking of ASEAN friends.

To increase the number of participation in the program, member universities have agreed to provide 5 full scholarships for their outgoing students. The scholarships cover living cost, insurance and airfare. Tuition fee is waived by host universities (receiving institutions). HOW TO JOIN ACTS

THE EXCHANGE PROCEDURE



Selection at Home University

1. Check academic calendar, latest submission and available courses of the host university you would like to attend at ACTS website
2. Discuss with your academic advisor
3. Visit ACTS website again to register yourself to get password and username
4. Complete online application form
5. Submit the printed online application form to your International Relations Office to be reviewed
6. If you meet the requirements, you will be nominated by your university

Selection at Host University

7. Once nominated, your application

could be reviewed by the host university

8. If you meet the requirements, the host university will approve the application

9. You have to confirm the acceptance. The host university will issue letter of acceptance based on student's confirmation

11. Once you have received the letter of acceptance, you need to make your travel arrangement

The Exchange Program

12. Upon your arrival, you have to register the courses you would like to take during the exchange program

13. Revise the courses selection at ACTS online application system if different

14. Generate learning agreement from the system to get approval from both universities

15. At the end of the exchange program, host university will evaluate your learning outcome and send the result to AUN-ACTS secretariat

After the Exchange Program

16. AUN-ACTS secretariat will issue your ACTS academic transcript and certificate of completion

17. Your home university will receive the certificate and transcript, then process the credit transfer

WHO ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

These are the minimum requirements to apply for ACTS mobility:

1. Enrolled as a degree student at one of AUN member universities
2. Have completed at least two academic semesters at home university
3. Have good academic standings at home university
4. Have good English proficiency in both speaking and writing
5. Have great interest to learn cultural diversity of ASEAN countries

Please note that each home and host university may have additional requirements. You could contact your International Relations Office or visit ACTS website to learn more about it.

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS

AUN member universities provide at least five full scholarships (AUN-ACTS Study Award) for their students to attend one semester exchange program at one of AUN member universities under ACTS scheme. The scholarships cover:

1. Accommodation
2. Living cost
3. Airfare
4. Insurance
5. Student Visa

Note: tuition fee is waived by host universities

For requirements and selection procedure to apply the scholarships provided by each AUN member universities may be different. You should contact International Relations Office (IRO) of your university to get more information about this.
